 - CCES PTA has a surplus right now, the proposed plan will be to roll most of the surplus into next year to supplement the budget, but also use a portion to make a gift to the school now.
 - President asks for a motion to authorize \$2000 spending by the executive committee for a gift for the school. Allie McDonald makes the motion, Julie Nichols seconds No debate, motion passes with administrators abstaining.
